

Navigation

- Hand Tool (H; spacebar for temporary switch)
- o Zoom Shortcuts
 - Fit Page in Window: Command-0
 - Fit Spread in Window: Command-Option-0
 - These zoom commands art "sticky" in InDesign

Views

- o Normal, Preview and Presentation Views
 - Press the W key to toggle between Normal and Preview
 - Press Shift-W to enter Presentation view—a full-screen, high-resolution view of your publication.
- Display Performance
 - Fast, Typical, and High-Quality
- Rulers
 - Command-R shows/hides rulers
 - Right-click on a rule to change your document's unit of measurement.
- Rotate Spread
 - Rotates the appearance of current spread by 90°, -90°, or 180°.
 - Does not affect the printing of the page.
