## InDesign Practical ::

Using the provided layout and resource files, recreate the InDesign document as shown on the handout.

- Replicate the **document setup** as closely as you can, including the number of pages and page layout, guides (margins, bleed, and column guides) and Parent pages. Use the information on the back of this sheet for the details.
- After your InDesign document is setup, layout **all four pages**, mirroring the example design as closely as possible. Consider placing the provided example PDF behind your work, on its own layer then change its opacity to 10%, to act as a tracing layer.
- The photography and artwork on the front (page 1) and back (page 4) pages **bleed off** the end of the page.
- The text in the two large text frames is provided in the InDesign exam resources folder. Note that this text is **exactly the same** between the two pages, including formatting. You can simply copy-and-paste this frame from one side to the other.
- For this text and all other areas of the document, match the original formatting as best you can, paying attention to the details (position, scale, size, leading, drop caps, etc.).
- The use of **Paragraph and Character Styles are not required** for this exam.
- All of the necessary photographs are provided but may not be exactly the size required by the layout. Do all of your work within InDesign—do not use other Adobe applications to alter the resources files.
- Name your file *lastname\_indesign\_exam.indd* and place it in the Google Drive Drop Box for this class. I only need the InDesign file—not the images or other supporting documents.

This practical component of the InDesign exam is worth 40 points.



### PAGES PANEL:

Pages 1 and 4 have the **A-Master** page applied to them, and pages 2 and 3 have the **B-Master** page applied to them.



### B-MASTER PAGE ITEMS:

- Automatic page numbers, and the "Coming Storm" and "Global Warming in North America" text at the bottom of the page.
- Drawn horizontal rules at top and bottom of page

*There are no items on the A-Master page*

- Adobe Garamond Pro Regular
- Adobe Garamond Pro Italic
- Open Sans Regular
- Open Sans ExtraBold



### DIMENSIONS:


- Page Size: **5.5" wide x 8.5" tall**


