Creating Links in HTML

Overview ::

For the exercise, you have been provided a complete website, albeit one missing most of its HTML links. This site also has some organizational and file naming issues that will need to be corrected.

With this folder, correct the file names, and create links where required. You do not need to worry about the visual presentation of these links—just create anchor links using Nova, Dreamweaver, or the HTML editor of your choice, and good old HTML. In the end, you should have a complete, functional website that is navigable within a Web browser.

Steps ::

1. Download the file called `Exercise_Resources_09` from the Exercises page on the class website to your personal computer. Rename the folder using your name in the following format: `lastname_firstname_09`.
- 2. Important First Step—Some of the HTML files provided have names that are not formatted correctly for use on the Web. **Change the names** of these files so that they conform to our file naming standards. At least one file is missing the correct file extension. The `common/` folder is perfect and does not need any updating/changes.

Do this before moving on to the next step. No, really—don't Pass Go until completing this step.

There are **five files** that need their names changed. Remember that `index.html` is the name of the file that the Web server will display by default—this should be the Home page of the site. The content of the `/common/` folder, however, do NOT need to be changed.

- 3. Add the following links to the pages specified.

Page	Instructions
All Pages	<p>Link the primary navigation links to their respective pages. Hint: Create your primary navigation on one page, then copy-and-paste the HTML across the other pages. The links will appear correctly once the right HTML code is applied to the navigation items.</p> <p>In addition to the primary navigation links, set the company logo as a link to the site home page.</p>
Home	Link the two <i>Learn more »</i> items at the end of the activity paragraphs to the Activities page.
Experiences	Link the four placeholder images to their proper thumbnails in the <code>art/</code> folder. In addition, set all of the photos to link to the full-size versions located in the <code>art/</code> folder.
Outdoor Links	Make all of the listed website links using the URL provided. Delete the link text with the parenthesis [(...)] after you have made the links.
Contact Us	Make the three e-mail address <code>mailto:</code> links.

- 4. For each page, change the `<title>` tag (the title that appears in the browser window) so that it is something other than the default.
- 5. Preview the site in a Web browser. You should be able to navigate the site without errors, with every page containing links to the other pages in the site.
