Soap Making

Many people do not realize how soap is actually made. It is not a product that a person can make in the evening and sell the next day.

First, all oils are measured to the gram and since some of them are solid, we melt them in a big capot. Next we measure the lye. Yes, all soaps are made with lye. We buy ours from a chemical company and are very careful with it. One tiny dry caustic soda bead on your skin will burn. It

must be measured by the gram (so do the other ingredients). All the ingredients are expensive so you do not want to mis-measure. (there is a learning curve) Water is added to the lye and it immediately heats up with no heat source.

When both the oils and the lye water cool down to anywhere between 110 and 125 degrees, we pour them together into the big pot. We then begin stirring and wait for it to saponify (a molecular change making soap and glycerin). When it changes from watery oil to vanilla pudding texture, we add the essential or fragrance oils. We then pour it into wooden molds, insulate it and let it heat up again on its own. When it cools (days) we then remove it, cut it and age it for weeks until it is ready to wrap. Meanwhile we are making labels and cutting fabric preparing for wrapping.
